In 2002, the Jamesville Dewitt Central School District set about to upgrade the building and athletic facilities at the High School campus. The contemplated building expansion, including a state-of-the-art Gymnasium and Classroom Addition, necessitated the reorganization of the circulation, parking and athletic facilities. Additional athletic fields were required due to overuse of the existing fields by both the School District athletic programs and the Town of Dewitt Recreation Department programs. Additional, the school district desired to develop a dedicated Varsity Girls Gamefield for soccer, lacrosse and field hockey with bleachers, scoreboard and perimeter fencing. Other project components included parking for 200 cars, relocation of the JV practice football field and renovations to the JV Softball and Baseball fields.

A rational plan was developed which provided for the building addition, the new and relocated athletic fields, convenient parking for the building addition and athletic fields, and for safe student-athlete access to and from the athletic fields. The plan also included a grand plaza at the Gym entrance which will be utilized for outdoor ceremonies.

In 1999, KFA prepared plans for the renovation of the Varsity Baseball and Softball fields.
